

PRIVACY POLICY

Collection and Use of Personal Information

Personal information is any information that can be used to identify you, and may include, but is not limited to, your name, telephone number, email address, postal or other physical address, and billing information.

Personal information also includes medical information about you and your health, as well as photographs of you, and our recommended course of treatment collected in our consultation.

By using our website and providing personal information to Ford Plastic Surgery, you are giving consent to us to use your personal and protected health information for certain activities, including treatment, communication with you or someone designated by you, communication with other medical personnel, billing and payment. For example, we may use and disclose protected health information about you so that Ford Plastic Surgery and its medical professionals can treat you. Disclosure to Third Parties

At times, Ford Plastic Surgery may also make certain personal information available to a marketing company that works with Ford Plastic Surgery to help us improve our services, and for advertising and marketing purposes.

Cookies and other Technologies

Cookies are routinely used by most websites including our website. By using our website, you allow us to use the information obtained by cookies.

Cookies do not gather or store any sensitive information, such as your user name or address or any other piece of information that might personally identify you. Cookies obtain impersonal information such as your IP address, how long you visited our website, the type of device you used to browse our website, your geographical location, which pages you viewed, the source that referred you to our website, your browser type and browser version.

We use the information obtained by cookies to monitor and track visitor usage in order to gather statistics on the type of users that view our website. These statistics help us keep our site user-friendly and provide relatable information to our site users.

We also use Google Analytics, a service provided by Google that prepares reports on visitors to our website by examining the cookies used on our website. Google will not link the information collected from cookies to identify the actual website user. These statistics are never shared, sold or given to any third party and are strictly used by Ford Plastic Surgery.

Finally, we use our cookies for Google remarketing, which allows us to advertise online using text or image ads on the Google Display Network. Remarketing is a feature that lets us reach people who have previously visited our site, and show
